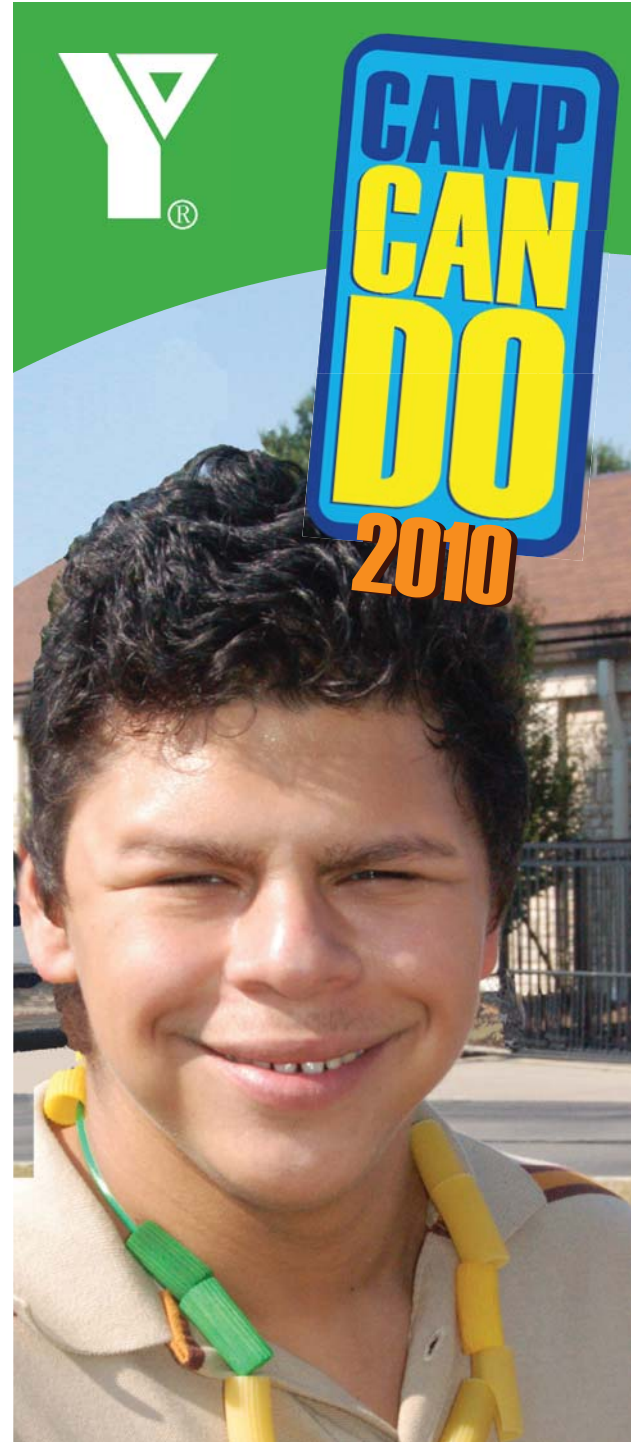

With **Camp Can Do**, the YMCA and the Early Childhood Resource Network+ (ECRN+) extend the opportunity to enjoy and participate in nature to our community's special needs population.

Running concurrently with YMCA Day Camp at five local YMCA branches, **Camp Can Do** is a summer day camp for children and young adults with moderate to intensive special needs, ages 6 through 21 years. Camp activities are tailored to the unique needs of these kids, with a staff of counselors at each site consisting of teachers from our local school districts experienced in working with children who have special needs.

NOTES FOR PARENTS

Camp Can Do runs five days a week Monday-Friday from 9:00am-12:00pm.

- ➔ The **Liberty** location meets on Mon., Wed. and Fri.
- ➔ The **Pickaway** location meets Mon.-Thur. in the afternoon.

A meeting between the lead counselor and each family will take place prior to the start of camp to ensure **Camp Can Do** is the right place for each and every child. To register, call the YMCA branch/Camp Can Do location your child will be attending. Contact information is listed on other side.

Campers will be outdoors for extended periods of time at Camp Can Do, please follow these suggestions to ensure your child has a safe and fun experience:

- ☀ **Campers swim every day! Swimwear is required.** Place your child's bathing suit on under their clothes, before they come to camp. Boys may wear swim trunks as shorts when not in the water.
- ☀ **Sun protection! Very Important!** Apply sunscreen to your child before dropping him/her off. Hats are also strongly suggested.
- ☀ **Hydration! Remember to pack a water bottle**, with your child's name marked on it.
