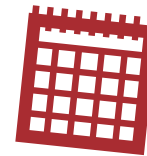
THE YMCA WORKS BEST WHEN EVERYONE'S INCLUDED

NOTES FOR PARENTS



Camp Can Do runs Monday-Friday from 9 am-12 pm.

- ☀️ Liberty Twp/Powell YMCA meets on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 9:30 am-12:30 pm.
- ☀️ Pickaway County Family YMCA meets Mon-Thur 12-3 pm.

A meeting between the lead counselor and each family will take place prior to the start of camp to ensure Camp Can Do is the right place for each and every child. To register, call the YMCA branch/Camp Can Do location your child will be attending. Contact information is listed on the back of brochure.

Campers will be outdoors for extended periods of time at Camp Can Do, please follow these suggestions to ensure your child has a safe and fun experience:

- ☀️ Campers swim every day! Swimwear is required. Place your child's bathing suit on under their clothes, before they come to camp. Boys may wear swim trunks as shorts when not in the water.
- ☀️ Sun protection! Very Important! Apply sunscreen to your child before dropping him/her off. Hats are also strongly suggested.
- ☀️ Hydration! Remember to pack a water bottle, with your child's name marked on it.
