## ADVENTURE

**Ground Initiatives/Teambuilding** – (10 years and older) Participants will attempt various ground level team initiatives ranging from name-games and ice breakers to brain teasers and physical challenges. Their missions will always require communication, problem solving and team work to succeed. This Session can be scheduled for 2 hours to a whole day, according to the goals of the group.

- (8-15 people \$60/hour)
- (16-30 people \$90/hour)
- (31-45 people \$120/hour)

**Climbing Tower** – (6 years and older) Participants will have the chance to pick their challenge on the three sides of our Climbing Tower. Walls range from 30 to 50 feet tall. \$75 per hour minimum 2 hours, up to 20 climbs per hour.

**Zip Line** – (12 years and older) Participants will have the chance to climb the wall, only to face their next challenge – zipping off the top of the tower on one of our racing zip lines! This Session should be scheduled for 2-3 hours according to the needs and level of the group. (Please note: participants must weigh between 40-250lbs) \$140 per hour minimum 2 hours, up to 14 zips in 2 hours.

**High Ropes Course** – (12 years and older) Participants will face a 10-element, high-level challenge course with giant swing, which encourages participants to push themselves individually, and in pairs. High Ropes provide opportunities for students to support one another and be a part of a memorable group experience! This Session is scheduled for 3-4 hours according to the needs and level of the group. (Please note: a minimum of 2 adult chaperones for every group up to 15 participants)

**Scales & Tails** – (Grades K-8) Get an up-close look and feel into the world of reptiles and amphibians. Students will have the chance to touch live animals ranging from toads and frogs to turtles and snakes.

**Incredible Insects** – (Grades K-5) The diversity of insects will be the focus as students forage in fields, turn over rocks and dig in tree stumps to collect their specimens. Insect classification, and various life cycles will be introduced and discussed.

**Water Wonders** – (Grades 2-5) Find out how ordinary water can do extraordinary things. Students will observe and perform experiments to better understand the amazing properties of water.

**Animal Adaptations** – (Grades K-5) Students will discover what makes animals unique and how they adapt to their environment through hands-on activities and games.

**Tree-Mendous** – (Grades 2-5) Students will learn about the structure of trees, discover their various functions and the important role they play in nature's balance.

**Senses Hike** – (Grades PreK-3) Students will explore their five senses while heightening their awareness of the environment. They will also discover that animals use their senses much like we do.

**Scientific Method** – (Grades 2-8) Students will discover the scientific method with the explosive fun of Alka-Seltzer rockets.

**Payment:** A non-refundable \$100 deposit is due along with the signed contract no later than 10 days after receipt of the contract. The deposit holds your program date and is deducted from the total amount due. Staffing for the program day is based upon the number of students quoted at the time of booking, thus the total amount due has also been determined and contracted according to this number. The Hoover Y-Park must receive the balance due no later than 4 weeks prior to the program date. Payments can be made using a check, money order, or purchase order.

**Cancellations:** All cancellations prior to the scheduled program date will forfeit the Non-refundable deposit (\$100) plus a \$50 cancellation fee.

**Inclement Weather:** The Hoover Y-Park cannot be held liable for conditions beyond its control. If a program is cancelled due to inclement weather, the park will make every effort to reschedule the group within a one-year period.

**Hold Harmless Agreement:** The attending organization agrees to hold harmless the Young Men's Christian Association, its agents and employees from all claims alleging bodily injury or property damage occurring while the undersigned uses the facilities owned or rented by the YMCA or is a participant in an activity sponsored by the YMCA.
