General Information and What to Bring

- Arrival & Departure** Men's Camp is designed to accommodate your busy schedule. The camp officially begins at 5:00 pm on Friday, August 27, 2010 and ends on Friday, September 3 at 1:00 pm. Hopefully, with your registration, you confirmed your arrival and departure times. If not, please let us know!

- Friday's Bird's Dinner** Men's Camp Officially begins with the Bird's Dinner. This optional dinner is held at the Harold Kerr Post 173 American Legion 120 Colton Ave (behind Pizza Hut off State Route 68). "Attitude Hour" begins at 6:00 pm and dinner begins at 7:00. There is an additional charge of \$15-20 for this wonderful meal and will be added to your Men's Camp invoice at the end of your stay.
- Rates** Rates are determined by the number of nights and meals you spend with us. Before your departure, please "check out" with the camp executive director to "settle up". Camp Willson accepts cash, check or credit card for payment.
- Cabins** You will have the opportunity to select your cabin. Winterized cabins, complete with restrooms are available; as well as our summer cabins, with a short walk to restroom. Sturdy wooden bunk beds are provided and campers are to bring their own bedding.
